

# TO ASK WHEN CHOOSING CBD OILS FOR YOUR PET



Liz Hughston is a credentialed Veterinary
Technician, VTS in Small Animal Internal
Medicine and Emergency and Critical Care, and
a Certified Veterinary Cannabis Counselor.
Here's what she tells people to look for when
selecting a CBD product for pets:

## Choose products specific to pets

Hughston recommends
veterinary-specific CBD
oils. Those made for
humans may have higher
levels of THC that can be
toxic to pets. Choose
products derived from
hemp, not marijuana. And
look out for toxic
ingredients like xylitol!

#### Look for a quality seal

Supplements are not FDA regulated. Look for products that adhere to voluntary manufacturing standards such as:

National Animal Supplement Council's Quality Seal Good Manufacturing Practice

### Ask for the Certificate of Analysis

This is a third-party, independent analysis of the product. Some of the information it includes is:

- CBD:THC ratio
- Breakdown of all cannabinoids in product
- Herbicide, Microbial and Heavy Metal testing
- Amount of CBD per tsp
- Complete ingredient list
