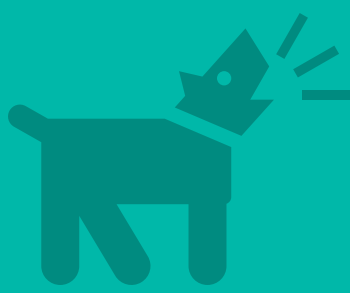
What dog is best for your family?
